

“This Man Has Done Nothing Wrong”
Luke 23:39-43

Biblical Truth: Jesus was crucified because Jesus was innocent.

1. Who was Jesus according to...

- Judas? “I have sinned by betraying innocent blood.” (Matt 27:3-4)
- The Religious Elite? Found no testimony against Jesus to put Him to death. (Mark 14:55)
- Governor Pilate? Found no guilt in Him. (John 18:38-19:6)
- Pilate’s Wife? “Have nothing to do with that righteous man”. (Matthew 27:19)
- King Herod? Did not find him guilty. (Luke 23:14-15)
- A Thief on a Cross? “This man has done nothing wrong.” (Luke 23:41)
- A Roman Soldier? “Certainly this man was innocent!” (Luke 23:47)

2. Who killed Jesus? (Acts 4:27-28)

- Herod.
- Pilate.
- The Gentiles.
- The Israelites.
- God.

3. Who gets to be with Jesus? (Luke 23:39-43)

Those who...

- Stop trying.
- Start trusting.

Admit that you are a sinner. (v41)

Believe that that Jesus has done nothing wrong. (v41)

Commit to follow Jesus wherever He goes. (v42)
