### **NUMBERS**

#### **DEUTERONOMY**

	READ	REFLECT
04/17:	Deut 4:1-40	See also <u>Deut. 6</u> & make observations re: the uniqueness of God. What does <u>6:4</u> mean for God to be one?
04/18:	Deut 7:1-9:6	What does it mean to be chosen by God? What are the responsibilities that come with that?
04/19:	Deut 10:12-22	See also <u>Deut. 11</u> . What are some of the expectations that come with a relationship with God?
04/20:	Deut 28	Why does God bless the obedient? Why does He curse the disobedient? See Gal. 3:13 and celebrate!
04/21:	Deut 30	How are we able to keep God's commands? Notice <u>vv11-14</u> and then see <u>Romans 10:6-10</u> .
04/22:	Deut 31	Notice how often "Be strong & courageous" is in <u>Deut. 31</u> & <u>Joshua 1</u> . Why is this repeated so many times?
04/23:	Deut 34	Moses was a faithful servant, but still a shadow of the Son to come. See Heb. 3:1-6 and give Him glory.

#### **JOSHUA**

READ	REFLECT
04/24: <u>Joshua 1</u>	Can success be guaranteed? If so, how do you get it? What exactly is biblical success?
04/25: <u>Joshua 2</u>	Rahab heard of God's works & she was saved. What does this say about the importance of testimonies?
04/26: <u>Joshua 3</u>	The priests stepped out by faith into an overflowing river. Where might God be calling you to do the same?
04/27: <u>Joshua 6</u>	What was God's part in the walls coming down vs. Israel's part? How can this apply to your life today?
04/28: <u>Joshua 7</u>	Revisit <u>6:17-19</u> . What does <u>ch7</u> 's account of Achan's sin say about our obedience and God's blessing?
04/29: Joshua 11	Notice v15. What would it look like in your life if you "left nothing undone" regarding God's commands?
04/30: Joshua 24	Regardless of others, Joshua chose to follow God. Would you still follow God even if no one else did?

## **JUDGES**

	READ	REFLECT		
05/0	01: <u>Judges 1-2</u>	The Israelites didn't drive out the people in <a href="mailto:ch1">ch1</a> & they went after false gods in <a href="mailto:ch2">ch2</a> . What is the correlation?		
05/0	02: <u>Judges 4</u>	Notice <u>v14</u> & <u>v23</u> . What does it mean for God to go before you? How can this be your prayer today?		
05/0	03: <u>Judges 6-8</u>	Notice Gideon in <u>ch6</u> & God's Words in <u>7:2</u> . Why is God pleased to use the weak to accomplish His will?		
05/0	04: <u>Judges 10-11</u>	What can we learn from Jephthah's life about the importance of not making deals with God?		
05/0	05: <u>Judges 13-16</u>	Notice 14:6; 14:19; 15:14. According to these verses, where did Samson get his strength?		
05/0	06: <u>Judges 17-18</u>	Notice 17:6 & 18:1. What's the correlation between not having a king & doing what's right in their own eyes?		
05/0	07: <u>Judges 19</u>	Notice 19:1 & see 21:25 (last verse in Judges). Whom have they rejected as King. What or Who is coming?		

<u>RUTH</u>		
	READ	REFLECT
05/08:	Ruth 1	Notice v16. Consider your relationships (family, friends, etc) & assess what makes them healthy/unhealthy.
05/09:	Ruth 2	Looking back on your life, can you trace God's sovereignty at work? Thank Him for His plan for your life.
05/10:	Ruth 3	Boaz was a kinsman-redeemer who acts on behalf of a relative in need. See Heb. 2:11 & Titus 2:14.
05/11:	Ruth 4	Boaz & Ruth married & gave birth to Obed. Why is this so significant? See Matt. 1:1-16 & Luke 3:23-38.
05/12:	Gal 4:1-7	In the fullness of time, God sent Jesus to redeem & adopt. Spend time thanking God for His redemption.
05/13:	Rom. 3:21-26	How specifically does God redeem through Jesus? What has God done? What must we do?
05/14:	Rom. 8:18-25	For those who in trust in Jesus, how is redemption something that has both happened and will happen?
