Focus: Chapter 6 No More Going Through the Motions

Theme: Purpose

Scripture Memory: John 10:10

Daily Devotions (Scripture & Meditation):

- **Monday:** Ecclesiastes 1
 - *Tony Evans says, "Plenty of men...know their names, occupations, and yet don't really know who they are at the core of their being."*
 - *Who are you and to whom do you serve?*
- **Tuesday:** Ecclesiastes 2
 - *"So when a man says, "I've gotta be me," he needs to ask himself this question: "Who is the me I've gotta be?"*
 - *Are you chasing the wind or chasing a Savior?*
- **Wednesday:** Ecclesiastes 3
 - Tony writes that what Solomon is saying in Ecclesiastes 3:2-8 "is that we live in a closed universe. An open universe means you control your own destiny. You have the final say. But in a closed universe, you don't have the final say."
 - What are your thoughts on "you cannot find your ultimate purpose in life by looking at life?"
- **Thursday:** John 10:1-17
 - Jesus said in John 14:6, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." In John 10:10, Jesus says, "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly."
 - Define "life" as you know and live it today.
 - Define "life" as Jesus taught in John 10 and within the New Testament.
 - What are the differences between your definition and Jesus' definition?
- **Friday:** Ecclesiastes 12
 - Verse 13 of Ecclesiastes 12 says, "The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments for this the whole duty of man."
 - Read Deuteronomy 6
 - Write down the similarities between the two texts.
 - What changes in your life now should be taken to reflect these commands now?
- **Saturday:** James 4
 - After reading James 4, do you see any similarities within the world today?
 - Are you contributing to the chaos or offering a different worldview to others through Christ?
- **Sunday (Accountability Day): John 10:10**
 - Ask a brother about the scripture memory for the week to keep each other accountable.

Weekly Challenge:

Are our dreams a mystery or a ministry? Whether we want to accept it or not, our sphere of influence is affecting others for Christ or not. Reflect on the vocations of life which we are in right now. Give an honest assessment of how we have impacted others for the Kingdom of God or not. Make the change. Seek forgiveness, repentance, and redemption. Find someone to hold you accountable for it.
