Text: Luke 24:13-35

Sermon Outline:

Biblical Truth: All Scripture is about Jesus.

Our prayer for you this year...

- 1. That your eyes are open to see Jesus.
- 2. That your mind is open to understand Jesus.
- 3. That your heart is open to believe in Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. It's a new year! It can be a new you! LOL. Are you a New Year's Resolution kind of person? If so, do you have any resolutions for 2023?
- 2. Have you ever read the Bible from beginning to end? If not, why not? If so, what was your experience? (Note: Our devotional plan for 2023 is not reading the entire Bible, but it is intended to keep up with our 52-week series: The Story.)
- 3. There are four different ways to digest God's Word: 1-Hearing, 2-Reading, 3-Studying, 4-Memorizing, 5-Meditating. Life change happens when #5 meets with any one of #s 1-4. Which is your favorite way to process Scripture?
- 4. Here are two good New Year's Resolution type quotes:
 - "If you aim at nothing, you will hit it every time!"
 - "If you fail to plan, you plan to fail!"

Do you have a devotional plan for 2023? If so, what is it? If you don't have one, have you considered the plan that lines up with our series: *The Story*? (Don't feel any pressure to use "this" plan. Although we DO want you to feel pressure to use "a" plan!)

- 5. Read Luke 24:13-35.
 - Specifically note verses 31-32, 44-45, 52-53.
 - Consider the sermon outline's 3 points (listed above).
 - Compare that with Question #3 above:
 - With your eyes you hear, read, study, and memorize.
 - With your mind you meditate on what you process with your eyes.
 - o And w/ your heart you believe what you see w/ your eyes and consider with your mind.

Discuss how God uses this process and prayer in regards to daily (and yearly) life change.
