Text: Romans 8

1.	You have been set free. a. From the Law. b. To live by the Spirit.	(1-17) (1-8) (9-17)
2.	You will be set free. a. From suffering. b. To live in glory.	(18-30) (18-25) (26-30)
3.	You will remain set free. a. From condemnation. b. To live in Christ.	(31-39) (31-36) (37-39)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read Romans 8:1-17. Many people don't become Christians because they want to keep their freedom. According to Romans 8, how are they grossly mistaken? If you are a Christian, share examples of how you have been set free in Christ.
- 2. Read Romans 8:18-30 and focus in on vv28-30. Consider that the "all things" are that which is alluded to in vv18-27. What is the "good" as it relates to vv28-30? How are you seeing God working all things for your good?
- 3. Read Romans 8:31-39. No one can undo what God has done. And in Christ, God hasn't just conquered your greatest enemy and overcome your greatest threat. He has turned them into his servants for your good. For instance: Suffering makes you more like Jesus; less stuff leads you to embrace God as your greatest treasure; uncertainty increases your faith; seeing brokenness around you lets the mercy of God flow through you; and death ushers you into God's presence. Where in your life has God made you more than a conqueror?
