- 4. Philippians 3:13-14. The church does not only consist of believers who are living in the world now. It also consists of believers past and future. Like being one of the runners in the middle of a relay race, you are carrying the baton for the team for this lap only. How do believers who were before you and believers who will come after you, give you endurance needed for the present?
- 5. Read Romans 8:32. How does Jesus' birth, death, and resurrection assure a better future for tomorrow and for eternity?
- 6. Reread Hebrews 12:1-2. What specifically was the joy set before Jesus? According to the gospel and its promises, what is the joy set before us?
