Sermon: Promises Kept

Text: Exodus 6:1-13

Sermon Outline:

Biblical Truth: God keeps His promises.

1. God will show you. (1)
2. God has remembered you. (2-5)
3. God will help you. (6-8)
4. God won't quit on you. (9-13)

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Exodus 6:1-2. Focus in on these two names of God: God Almighty and the LORD (the Existing One). What do these names say about God in regards to the Israelites' problem (i.e. Pharaoh) and in regards to the problems you are facing?
2. Read Genesis 15:13-14 and Exodus 6:3-5. Israel's situation in Egypt was no surprise to God. And God knows about every single one of your circumstances too. Have you ever thought that maybe God doesn't know about (or care about) a particular problem you are dealing with? How does it change your perspective when you realize that God sees and God knows (Exodus 2:25)?
3. Read Exodus 6:6-8 and identify the specific ways in which God said He would help the Israelites. Which of these best describes how you currently desire God's help?
4. Read Exodus 6:9-13. Can you identify with how the Israelites or Moses felt? How encouraging is it that God didn't second guess His plan or ability? In the midst of hard times, how simple, difficult, and crucial is it to just keep your focus on God (specifically His character, and His power)?
5. Read Romans 8:32. Jesus didn't come to Earth *and* live for you *and* die for you because He needed you. He came because you need Him. How does the cross prove that God will continue to advocate for you and never give up?
