God Saves Us...

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read Exodus 16:1-3. The Israelites did not trust God with their future and feared they would die from hunger. If applicable, discuss specific fears you have regarding what lies ahead.
- 2. Read Exodus 17:1-3 & Romans 8:32. God did not sacrifice His Son just to turn His back on you when you struggle. If applicable, where are you having a difficult time believing God will come through? If applicable, where have you seen faith overcome fear in your life?
- 3. Read Exodus 18:13-23. A huge problem some face is that they <u>don't</u> need bread and they are <u>not</u> facing a battle. This leads to them thinking that they are ok and can handle everything. Where in your life do you feel you need to be saved from trying to do life without help from God?
- 4. Read Exodus 19:1-6. If you are a Christian, you are loved by God, not because of what you have done but because you are His treasured possession. Before you knew Christ, you lived away <u>from</u> God and <u>for</u> yourself. Now God has saved you <u>from</u> yourself and <u>for</u> Himself. How should it motivate you to know that you are immensely treasured by God?
- 5. Read Exodus 20:1 & Romans 10:17. God saves us by His Word and He keeps on saving us by His Word. How have you experienced the saving power of God's Word since becoming a Christian?
