Sermon: Look and Live Text: Numbers 1-36

Sermon Outline:

- 1. God's will is that our lives be oriented towards Him. (1:1-10:10)
- 2. Sin both causes and is caused by disorientation from Him. (10:11-19:22)
- 3. God's faithfulness calls us to reorient our lives in Him. (20:1-36:13)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read Numbers 9:15-23. God's will is that our lives be oriented towards Him. Are the decisions you make and the actions you take (when to stay/go, in what direction, and with whom) directed towards God? For instance:
 - When you make decisions regarding where to live, what job to take, what school to attend, who to date (or to marry), where and to what extent to be generous?
 - What news to share, what secrets to keep, what sin to hide/disclose?
 - Where to serve, what to give your time to, how to use your influence?
- 2. Read Numbers 11:4-6 and 13:27-14:4. Israel had become disoriented and wanted to go back to Egypt.
 - Why did they complain about their current circumstances?
 - If applicable, how has sin caused you to long for the way things used to be?
 - How has that longing led you to sin?
- 3. Read Numbers 21:4-9, John 3:14-15, and Hebrews 12:1-2.
 - Do you think of all who were bitten and looked at the bronze snake on the pole, some had more faith than others?
 - If so, which ones were healed?
 - What must we now do to find healing, rescue, and even faith today?
- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 10:1-11.
 - Why was Numbers written?
 - Why was it included in the Bible?
 - Why must we read it?
